The following contains information regarding the conduct of the 2014 Southern Surf League together with the conditions governing each event in the programme.



1. TEAM COMPOSITION

Each team will comprise maximum fourteen (14) members from the same club, 8 must be from the primary club for the 2013-2014 Competitive season:

- 1 Team per Club
- Minimum 4 x females
- Manager

Draft team list along with any draft athletes must be declared to Surf Life Saving Southern Region by 5pm Friday 31st January 2014.

Late changes can be made on the day at the Managers Meeting

3. DISQUALIFICATION

Disqualification from events is seen as a last resort for major breaches of the rules only.

To ensure smooth running of the Southern Surf League there is an immediate disqualification for any false start.

4. POINT SCORE

- a) Points will be awarded from 1st to 6th Place only. 6 points for first down to 1 point for 6th
- b) In the Surf Races and Board Races points will be scored on a 'teams' basis. The two starters in each team will have their result added and the aggregate matched against those from other teams. The team with the lowest aggregate will be declared the winner. Please note that all competitors must complete the course to gain points
- c) In all events, with the exception of the Beach Flags, where disqualified, a team will get zero points. In the Beach Flags the team will score those points earned up until the disqualification.
- d) Points will accumulate throughout the day, so that only the top 6 teams will go through to the Dear love. In the event of a draw for the top 6 teams, a count back may be used to determine the top 6.

7. POWERPLAY

Prior to the commencement of competition for the day, Team Managers will declare to the Event Manager, their designated 'Power Play' event. On completion of the designated event the team will score double points for that particular event

8. EVENT CONDITIONS

- a) IRB driver and crewperson cannot change during the event.
In regards to the IRB team please note that the driver and crewman can only compete in the IRB races and the Beach Relay.
- b) **Prizes.** The Southern Surf League Club trophy will also be awarded for the top club team.
- c) Except where specified in the Event Rules, the General Competitive Conditions outlined in the current SLSNZ Southern Region Competition Manual for Southern Surf League, plus any subsequent circulars will apply to the conduct of these events.
- d) The Event Referee for the event is Dave Price
- e) **Protests.** No protests will be accepted during the event, the Event Referee's decision is final

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
