Competition Rules;

as per Surf Sport competition Manual 8th Edition (V1)

Event Conditions;

By resolution of the Local Sport Committee an **entry fee of \$15.00 per competitor** applies to all entries into the 2013-14 Hawke's Bay Championships (inclusive of all three dates) Note only exception is IRB patients if not involved in any other events.

Hawke's Bay Championship events will be run using **competition numbers** to identify all competing athletes. Clubs are required to complete and send, a manifest detailing the names and corresponding competition number of all club members competing in each day of the HB Championships 2013-14 to jacob.davies@surflifesaving.org.nz by Tuesday the 4th of February.

Entries will be accepted on the day at the discretion of the event referee.

Competitors must display their distinctive competition number clearly marked on the upper left and right arms for the duration of each round.

Failure to display a competition number will result in a competitor being prevented from starting and / or disqualification.

Hawkes Bay Pennant Points will be awarded to the first three Hawkes Bay finishes in all finals.

The Event Referee reserves the right to place a minimum of three Hawkes Bay competitors in all finals should heats have taken place.

All competitors must wear a high viz vest for all water events, no exceptions.
