Gear trailers can be brought onto the beach at the South End gate access (4WDs only). No vehicles to be left on the beach. Please park in designated zones. Avoid parking trailers and vehicles on the footpath where possible.

Points:

1st = 6 Points
2nd = 5 Points
3rd = 4 Points
4th = 2 Points
5th = 1 Points

Note: There are no points for Team/Relay Events

Age Grade Terminology: Please use the 'under' terms when referring to Junior Surf Age Groups i.e. Under 14, Under 13 etc. This will ensure consistency between events, officials and when recording results.

Competitor Behaviour: A reminder to all competitors, coaches and team managers that aggressive or inappropriate behaviour shown by any competitor will not be accepted. Our Officials and Lifeguards in the water are watching closely and anything deemed to be overly aggressive or outside the 'nature of the sport' could lead to the competitor being disqualified and/or points being deducted from the Club.

Wetsuits:	<p>The decision to allow wetsuits will be made by the Event Referee pending water temperature and weather conditions on the day of the event. <i>All variations of wetsuits will be allowed, however competitors should note they are meant to keep you warm, not as a flotation aid.</i></p> <p>Consultation will be held with Team Managers, who are then responsible for communicating the decision to their members.</p> <p>It is recommended that all parents prepare for events by <u>always</u> packing a wetsuit for their child/children, regardless of the weather forecast. This way if a ruling is made to allow wetsuits your child will not be hindered.</p>
Safety Vests:	<p>It is compulsory for all Surf Sport competitors to compete wearing a SLSNZ sanctioned fluoro safety vest. This applies to any competitor entering the water. It is not expected competitors wear the vests during Beach Flags or Beach Sprints.</p>
Body Board Leashes:	<p>All competitors must be present on the start line of the Boogie/Body Board race with leashes attached to the boards and to the competitors. Any competitor found not to meet this requirement will be given the opportunity to find a replacement Boogie/Body Board before they commence racing.</p>
Parent/Helper Behaviour:	<p>A reminder that no matter what role you hold on the day of an event any abuse or interference from any person will not be tolerated, and any parent/helper/coach judged to show behaviour that is obstructive, offensive or dangerous will be asked to leave the beach.</p>
Competition Disputes:	<p>No 'protests' regarding Official rulings will be accepted during local events. If you witness any unfair or aggressive behaviour from a competitor or club member or are unhappy with a ruling/results inform your Team Manager who can then discuss with the Arena Referee.</p>
Results:	<p>Final results will be posted approximately one week after the competition on the SLSNZ web pages and the Capital Coast Facebook page.</p> <p>Individual winners (1st, 2nd, and 3rd) will still be awarded their ribbons immediately after their event. Series winners will be awarded their medals at the Awards Function after the competition concludes.</p> <p>More details below.</p>
