All Clubs are invited to attend a Strategy Workshop which will be held at **10.30am on Saturday, 24th September 2016** at the **Heritage Hotel, Auckland**, prior to the 2016 Annual General Meeting of Surf Life Saving New Zealand (“SLSNZ”)

Clubs are invited to send their Chairperson (or an appropriate alternative delegate) to attend this session. Logically to minimise Clubs travel costs the workshop attendee would be the same person as attending the AGM and the Awards Dinner that follows. Due to capacity limits at the venue it will only be possible for clubs to send one delegate.
