### Event Overview

The Eastland Port 2018 Champion of the Bays competition offers almost all the events available at the 2018 NZ Championships and the BP Surf Rescue NZ Championships. The event draws upon the best of the best from the Gisborne and Bay Of Plenty areas testing both their speed and endurance, to determine the 2018 Champion of the Bays.

**Racing Uniform:** Club Caps are compulsory

**Helmets:** As this is a SLSNZ sanctioned event helmets are compulsory for all IRB Patients, Crew Person and Drivers in competition and competition training.

- Please note the surf race event will be held as a combined event with the surf teams event.

## Club Requirements to Provide Officials

There will be strict adherence to the Officials Ratio Policy of 1 official for every 10 club competitors. The names of your Club Officials will required via the EnterNow Online entry system. At the close of entries, if there is a shortfall of Officials, a request will go out to the Team Managers to ensure they meet their 1:10 Official to athlete ratio. Additional names must be given to the Event Manager if not. This will be enforced strictly and clubs may not be allowed to compete if their named Officials are not at the Official briefing.

## Composite Teams

Where athlete numbers and field size allow, clubs may enter composite teams. For example, Wainui and Whangamata may combine its athletes to field a Taplin Relay. You must enter a portion of your team in the online entry system, and composite teams will be finalised at marshalling. This will not occur if it will require the running of additional heats. Composite Teams results will not count for points or medals.

## Non-qualified Lifeguards

Non-qualified lifeguards may not enter the event

## Dress of Competitors

Competitors are required to wear High Visibility Vests and club caps, however the following rule changes will also be applied: from the Surf Sport Manual 9<sup>th</sup> Ed (v1).

*2.6. Dress of Competitors, 2.6.11. In team Events there must be uniformity in terms of competition caps and high visibility vests colour(s) to assist with team identification. (Tog colours uniformity removed)*

*2.7. Competition Caps, 2.7.1. Competition caps, colours and designs, must be approved and registered with SLSNZ. Only registered colours and caps shall be permitted to be worn. In team Events Competitors from the same team must wear matching caps. A register of club caps can be found on the SLSNZ website and applications for changes are to be made to the Sport Manager directly.*

## Clashing of Events / Age Categories

We will not be holding events for any competitor. If your competitor is not on the line ready then they will not start in that heat, semi, or final.

**Individual Events:** athletes may only compete in their specific age group. They will not be able to compete up for this event. For example, an U19 athlete will have to compete in the U19 age category, they will not be able to compete up in the Open age category. This is due to programme timings.

**Teams Events:** athletes may compete up in age groups to fill team positions, however they may only compete in any team event once, ie in one age category. The entry system cannot monitor this, we will be placing our trust in the team coaches that this will be adhered to.

## Presentations

At the end of the day's events we will be presenting medals to all 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place getters in each event that was contested. At the conclusion of the event we will be awarding medals to the overall Male and Female winners in each of the Age Categories, and the Ralph Morse Shield and the Bay of Plenty Top Club Trophy (historical trophies), Awarded to the Top Club from Gisborne and the Bay of Plenty/Coromandel respectively

## Event Draws

Event heat draws will be made via the Waves iPad system as the athletes are marshalled.

## Club Trailers

Club gear trailers can be parked in parking spaces designated at Churchill Park.

## Notes

In the event of the poor Surf Conditions, the competition will be relocated to a more appropriate venue. All competitors will be notified through the SLSNZ Eastern Region Facebook page. [Click here](#) to view the page.
