Entry Process:

All competitors a required to be entered in the event via the online entry system. Entries will close Friday 2nd Feb at 10am.

Competitor Eligibility:

Competitors must:

- a) Be a Refreshed Surf Lifeguard for the current season OR a newly qualified Surf Lifeguard in the current season,
- b) Be a Current Member of a SLSNZ Affiliated Club,
- c) Have a Primary Membership with the club they intend to compete for.

Age group:

Competitor age groups are defined as the competitor's age at midnight on 30th September 2017. For example, if you were 23 by the 30th of September 2017, you are ineligible to compete in the Under 23 division.

Team Substitutes:

All team substitutes must be registered in some capacity in the competition. This means that if an athlete is competing in any event for example the surf race they are registered for the event. In some instances clubs have to substitute members for their team events which can be problematic if the person who is the substitute is not competing in any other event.

This is to allow fairness to all by ensuring that all eligibility criteria are met. The Online Event Entry System will only allow you to enter 'complete' teams.
