The trial day is open to all club IRB Teams wishing to seek selection as a New Zealand IRB Team who will compete at the World Lifesaving Championships in November 2018 in Adelaide.

Saturday 21st April 2018: 9.00am racing starts, High Tide 0917, Low Tide 1530.

If there are only enough crews for a final, crews will race three rounds per event. If there are heats then crews will race the heats plus an A and B final.

When entering the selection trial you will need to bring the following equipment and understand the gear rotation for this trial.

Equipment to Bring:

- A fully operational IRB (with V Strips), engine, lifejackets, helmets.
- Your own competition food, drink etc..

Tents:

- Please let mike.lord@surflifesaving.org.nz if you need to borrow a 3x3 tent for the trial as we have some spare.

Equipment Rotation:

- When racing at Worlds you use pool equipment so we will be rotating crews around the lanes and equipment during the events so we run a fare trial and crews get used to the system run at Worlds.
