The Surf Lifeguard Award certifies that the holder has the basic skills and knowledge to be a Surf Lifeguard. This is the entry level qualification for members to be a patrolling member.

The Surf Lifeguard Award is the first step on the Surf Life Saving New Zealand lifeguard pathway.

This season we will be booking space at QE2 earlier in the week of the exam to complete the pool components and theory exam. **More information to come.**

Later in the week, in this case Thursday 28th February 2019, will be to cover First Aid, CPR, Radio, Signals, Run-Swim-Run, Tube Rescue and Recovery Position.

This will be the last scheduled exam to take place in the evening.
