For Open management positions at this stage the plans are for all roles to be volunteer roles – i.e. no paid roles or honoraria, due to the very high costs for the upcoming two year campaign. This will be reviewed as part of the detailed budgeting process, but any applications should be on the basis of the above.

In addition to the specific skills and experience sought for each role, all successful applicants will demonstrate:

- A successful record with teams at national or regional level.
- Proven leadership skills.
- Exceptional interpersonal and communication skills.
- Strong organisational and time management skills.
- An ability to identify and implement improvements.
- Rapport and respect from the surf lifesaving community.
