The first beach event of the season is here! Keep reading for important information about the event. All other information can be found in the 2019/20 Capital Coast Event Circular found on the event page [here](#).

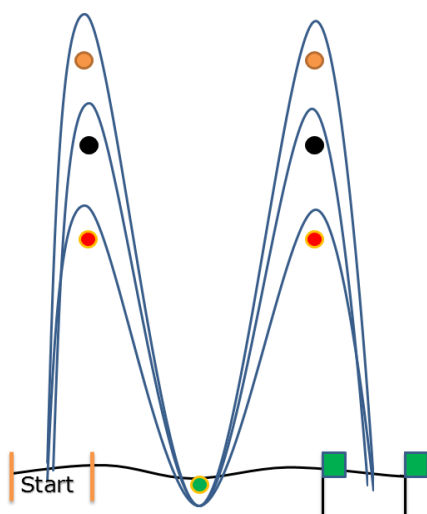
Date: Sunday 10 November 2019
Venue: Petone foreshore, opposite Beach Street. See map below.
Entries close: Wednesday 6 November
Cost: \$5 per competitor
Late entries \$15 per competitor on top of normal entry fee.
There will be **no removal/deletion** of entries after the close of entries i.e. all entries in EnterNOW at close of entries will be charged.

Surf Officials Meeting: 8.00am on beach
Team Managers Meeting: 8.30am on beach
Racing Starts: 9.00am

Programme:

Board races x 2
Ski races x 2
Surf race x 1
Surf boat Long Course x 3
Surf canoe Long Course x 3

- Board, Ski and Swim races will be on an M shape course. The seaward turning buoys will be set at the distance as specified in the Surf Sport Competition Manual. The shore turning marker will be in shallow water and will require dismount from your board or ski.



In it for life



We are again allowing members that have yet to gain their Lifeguard Award to compete. There is a separate event for this in the entry system. They will need to have a 200m badge recorded against their membership in PAM to be able to be entered.

Surf officials.

You are required to supply 1 qualified surf official for every 10 athletes at the event. When you are doing your entries please fill out the details of the officials from your club that will be attending this event.

Parking and beach access.

Parking will be in the public carpark along the foreshore. Parking space will be limited so please make sure you are there early with your trailers to get a park. Access to the carpark is only available when you are heading west along The Esplanade.

Beach access for boats and canoes will be on the western side of the Heretaunga Boating Club, once you have dropped your trailer please park in the public carpark away from the boating club.
