Prerequisites: 16 Years of age and 2 years patrolling experience
Marine VHF Radio Operators Certificate
Current First Aid Level 1 (Unit Standards 6400, 6401 and 6402)
Surf Lifeguard Award (refreshed)
Current member of an SLS club
