



## **COROMANDEL CUP**

**WEDNESDAY 8<sup>TH</sup> JANUARY 2020**

### **Entry**

There is no charge for the Coromandel Cup. Athletes will need to give their name to their age group manager on the day.

### **Team Managers & Officials Meeting**

Team Managers meeting will begin at 8:00am inside the Annex at the surf club. Official and helpers meeting will start at 8:30am. Clubs must provide parents to help out on the day.

### **Competition Events**

All events will be conducted as described in the NZ Junior surf Manual, but may be altered by the carnival controller as required. Heats will be conducted if required. Finals for each event will run at the conclusion of the heats for that event.

All competitors must be on the SLSNZ Database and hold appropriate qualifications. A current 200m Swim Badge is required for all water events.

### **Age Groups**

Under 7, Under 8, Under 9, Under 10, Under 11, Under 12, Under 13, Under 14

Age is taken at midnight on September 30<sup>th</sup> 2019. Girls and boys will race separately.

All children over 8 must have completed their 200m badge.

### **Uniform**

Competitors must wear club togs, high visibility vests and club competition caps (Registered by SLSNZ). A discussion may be had at the managers meeting around wetsuits if the weather turns poorly

## Points

Points will be allocated to the first three place getters for all individual events. and certificates will be awarded to the overall place getters in each age group.

If there are individuals on equal points, the person who was placed higher in the Body Board race (u7,u8,u9) or the Diamond (u10,u11,u12,u13,u14) will be awarded the higher place, otherwise an equal place will be given.

Individual Points 1<sup>st</sup> = 3 points 2<sup>nd</sup> = 2 points 3<sup>rd</sup> = 1 point

Only Coromandel Clubs can earn points toward the cup. All individual points will be accumulated and The Coromandel Club with the most points will be awarded the Coromandel Cup for 2019. If a non Coromandel Club competitor has earned individual points the next Coromandel place getter will earn the club points.
