There are no limits on the number of applicants from a club.

Timelines for Regional Service Awards

23 January 2020: Nomination forms for 2020 Awards available on the SLSNZ

website for clubs to access.

31 March 2020#: Nominations close for Central and Southern Regions. Nominations

should be returned by clubs to the appropriate Regional office.

17 May 2020#: Nominations close for Northern and Eastern Regions. Nominations

should be returned by clubs to the appropriate Regional office.

Note – this date may differ to the local Awards of Excellence deadlines. The Regions will advise these deadlines separately.

April to June 2020: Regional Honours & Awards Committees to select recipients for

2020 awards.

May - July 2020: Awards Functions held in conjunction with Local Awards.

Clubs do <u>not</u> need to make any specific nominations for any of the <u>above</u> awards at a National level.

In addition, there are four levels of **Service Awards.** These are:

- Service
- Distinguished Service
- Life Membership
- 50 Year Badge

A points system is used to determine eligibility for the Service, Distinguished Service and Life Membership awards. The detail on the points scoring system is set out in the spreadsheet itself (*please use the latest version - 2020*). The 50 Year Badge has a simpler application form – also available from the SLSNZ website

And as usual, a Regional/ District Service award is a pre-requisite for a National Service Award.

Note: clubs must apply for all Service Awards – they are not granted automatically.

23 January 2020: Nomination forms for 2020 Awards available on the SLSNZ

website for clubs to access.

30 June 2020: Nominations close. All Nominations should be returned by clubs to

SLSNZ (Attention: Chief Executive).

July 2020: National Honours Awards Committee to finalise recommendations for

2020.

August 2020: Board Confirmation of Honours & Awards for 2020.

19 September 2020: Honours & Awards presented at 2020 Awards of Excellence function

following the AGM.

General Comments on Service Awards

 As noted earlier, SLSNZ service awards are not automatically granted, they still need to be applied for, i.e. Clubs still need to submit award nominees applications to the appropriate Honours & Awards Committee for consideration.

- The points thresholds are guides only. Honours & Awards committees have complete discretion to award, or not award, Service Awards.
- The Honours and Awards Committees may grant exceptions for "special circumstances".
- Nominations for posthumous awards will not be considered.
- For 2020 there has been an update to some point allocations specifically for the roles of Lifesaving Instructor (Club Points), Examiner (Regional Points) and Patrol Auditor (District Points) the points have increased from 1 point per year to 2 points per year.

Key points to remember when making submissions

- All applications need to be completed in full to be considered.
- Only a Club Chair or President may submit a nomination.
- Please ensure the SLSNZ PAM database is correct and updated with all the Nominees positions, honours and awards as all nominations will be checked against the SLSNZ PAM database record and may be returned to Clubs / Regions as incomplete if significant divergence is evident.
- The Nominees will be required at the time of acceptance of the Award to verify the correctness of information provided on their behalf and confirm that SLSNZ, Regions and Clubs may use the information for publicity and promotional purposes.
- Members who are paid more than out of pocket expenses for a task receive reduced points for those tasks as per the schedule. Voluntary activity should still be recognised i.e. a paid administrator that is also the voluntary club instructor should be recognised in the latter position.
- Members can be fast-tracked if they are found to be eligible for a higher award.
- The 50 Year Badge Award is for 50 years of service to SLS and does not necessarily need to be consecutive. Note: the 50 Year Badge has its own application form – it does not use the spreadsheet used for the other awards.
