COURSE OVERVIEW

The Surf Lifeguard Award certifies that the holder has the basic skills and knowledge to be a Surf Lifeguard. This is the entry level qualification for members to be a patrolling member.

The Surf Lifeguard Award is the first step on the Surf Life Saving New Zealand lifeguard pathway. Tuesday at Taiora: QEII is the 400m swim and theory exam.

Thursday at TBC is the practical beach components.

Complete all practical requirements as necessary
Complete all theory requirements – full workbook completion prior to weekend is mandatory for some qualification.
