

4. MEMBER DIRECTIVES

4.1 Commencement Date

- 4.1.1 This General Regulation shall take effect and come into force on 24 Feb 2013.

4.2 SLSNZ Colours and Blazers

- 4.2.1 The badge or logo of SLSNZ, which is a registered trademark of SLSNZ, shall be as set out in **Appendix 8**. This trademark may only be used by SLSNZ and may not be copied in part or whole without written permission of the Chief Executive.
- 4.2.2 The red and yellow skull cap and red and yellow flag, as depicted in **Appendix 8**, are owned by SLSNZ. They shall be used by Clubs in accordance with the Sponsorship Regulations.
- 4.2.3 The official SLSNZ blazer shall be of plain material and shall have on the breast pocket the badge of SLSNZ as specified in **Appendix 8**. Any alterations or additions to the badge shall be allowed only with prior written approval of the Chief Executive.
- 4.2.4 Only those persons who have received Life Membership of SLSNZ shall be entitled to wear the SLSNZ Blazer.
- 4.2.5 New Zealand Representative blazer and/or tracksuit
- (a) The New Zealand Representative blazer and/or tracksuit shall be of black, white and/or grey material.
 - (b) The New Zealand Representative blazer and/or tracksuit will be embroidered with the SLSNZ fern, as specified in **Appendix 8**.
 - (c) The honour to be embroidered on the New Zealand Representative blazer and/or tracksuit shall be limited to the event and locality at which the member represented SLSNZ and the year of representation. e.g. "SLSNZ Representative Team, Event, Date."
 - (d) No other badge or identification shall be permitted to be worn on the New Zealand Representative blazer.
 - (e) The New Zealand Representative blazer shall be worn only by representatives accredited by the Board.
 - (f) No New Zealand Representative blazer and/or tracksuit shall be obtained by persons except with written authority of the Chief Executive and such written authority shall detail the design and lettering to be embroidered on the item.

- 4.2.6 Persons appointed by the Board as delegates for and on behalf of SLSNZ to attend overseas or World Surf Lifesaving and related organisations' meetings, schools, seminars and conferences shall wear the SLSNZ blazer and/or badge and/or silver fern as determined by the Board.

4.3 Club Colours

- 4.3.1 Each new Club shall apply to SLSNZ to register its proposed competition cap design, which shall be subject to the endorsement of SLSNZ through the Chief Executive.
- 4.3.2 Clubs colours or competition caps shall not be altered without the approval of the Chief Executive of SLSNZ.
- 4.3.3 SLSNZ shall maintain a competition cap register.
- 4.3.4 Every three years SLSNZ will up-date the competition cap register.
