Please find below some further information for various events in the programme based on questions that have been received in the lead up to the Central Region Champs.

RFID Tags – Senior & Junior Champs

We will be using RFID tags for both days of the competition.

I do understand that this is late notice but we are evidently attempting to gain some momentum with the use of these tags for the rest of the season. As competing members will be required to use them throughout Eastern Regional Champs / Oceans and TSB Nationals, I am hoping to alleviate some stress for the Central Region membership heading into the rest of the season.

From here, if all team managers could please send me a list for any members that require a new / replacement tag for the event.

This list of names needs to be email to troy.greenem@surflifesaving.org.nz by Friday morning at 0900.

If any member has been allocated 3 or more tags up to this date, they will then be charged \$5 per replacement tag from here onwards. Due to having to order these tags and manually allocated each one to an athlete the overall costs become extremely high if athletes are requiring a new one every single event or season.

For Oceans athletes who competed last season and have a RFID tag, they do not require a new one, they are welcome to get a new one if they wish at no cost.

For any athletes who are unsure if they have the correct tag or evidently have their siblings tag or any other issues relating to their current RFID tag, Mark Inglis and Myself will be at the Fitzroy SLSC from 4pm until 6pm on Friday 8th of Jan to assist any members having any issues.

This will be the only session we will be hosting throughout the championships, if there are any individual issues through the competition I will be more than happy to assist when possible.

All new tags will be available to pick up either on Friday evening or Saturday morning at the Team Managers briefing.

Late Entries

As of Thursday 7th Jan, there will be no removal of entries from either the Senior or Junior Championships.

Any team changes must be made with the appropriate forms.

Late entries will be taken into consideration but are not guaranteed to be accepted as programs have been finalised
