## Event Entry Process

Entries are made by using the SLSNZ Online Event Entry System. To access the EnterNow system please follow this [link](#) and use your club allocated password details as sent to the club administrators.

*Any secondary school teams wishing to enter, please email [Troy Greenem](#) to receive an electronic entry form.*

### Please note:

- **We ask clubs to only enter athletes in events that they intend on competing in.**
- **Team Manager's contact details:** Must be updated on the online system to ensure that the relevant person receives all updated information directly. Failure to list a team manager may mean that you will miss out on vital information.
- **Entering Teams:** You must enter the required number of people as specified for team events otherwise your entry in that event will not be accepted.

All entry fees will be calculated via the online entry system following the close of entries and your club will be invoiced directly. The entry system allows clubs to download a quote for the event to use as reference which can be found at the bottom of the event entry page. Any athlete that shows up and races but is not entered will be invoiced as a late entry.

## Eligibility of Competitors

This competition is open to any SLSNZ affiliated club. Without the following details your members will not be eligible to compete nor will they be able to be entered through the online entry system. SLSNZ reserve the right to limit the number of competitors per event.

As this is also a Secondary Schools competition, we will be accepting entries from any schools wishing to compete. All entries must be completed by one contact from each school.

## Age

The NZ Pool Events programme is scheduled before the beach based events for the current season and therefore a competitor's age group is determined by their age as at midnight on 30 September 2021. This is to allow athletes to remain in the same age group for the entire season. For example, if you are 14 on 30 of September 2021, you are not eligible to race in the U14 age group and will be in the U15 age group.

### Please Note:

1. All competitors must be aged 11 years or older before midnight 30 September 2021 to be eligible to compete in this event.
  2. Competitors (individual and team events) may compete in age groups as detailed below:
    - U11 may compete only in U12 events
    - U13 may compete only in U14 events
  3. **Competitors can only compete in one individual age group event, but are able to enter team events of their own age and one age group above.** For example an U12 competitor wishing to compete in the 50m with Fins may only compete in the U12 age group event. An U12 athlete may compete in the U12 relay as well as the U14 relay.

## Timekeepers

A large number of time keepers and water crew are required to ensure the successful running of the event. As such, each competing club will be required to supply timekeepers for the event. The exact number of these will be communicated to you after the close of entries and will be decided based on the number of entries from your club.

## Event Rules and Events Contested

Pool Competitions will be conducted under the rules as published in the SLSNZ Pool Championships Competition Manual. This manual is based upon the International Life Saving (ILS) World Championship Rules.

The SLSNZ Pool Competition Manual, 25m Pool, Short Distance Events, applies to this event. Copies can be obtained [here](#).

## In Pool Lifeguards

In pool lifeguards are required to ensure the successful running of the Hawkes Bay Pool Champs. These guards are required to move around gear and help set and reset the lanes. As such, each competing **Surf Club** will be required to supply two (2) lifeguards during the competition.

### Points:

Points are awarded as follows:

- 1<sup>st</sup> place – 5 points
- 2<sup>nd</sup> place – 4 points
- 3<sup>rd</sup> place – 3 points
- Non-placing competitor\* – 1 point

\*must complete event to obtain points

Races will be run as timed finals. Each competitor will swim once and the placing's will be determined by times.

## Surf Life Saving Club Competition

The Surf Life Saving Club with the most points at the end of competition wins the Surf Life Saving Pool Championship. There will be a trophy awarded to the top club this year. Only SLSNZ members are eligible to compete in the SLS title events.

## School Competition

Schools compete for Royal Life Saving trophies under one of the following categories:

- *Vigor Brown Shield* - Top Boys High School (all competitors for the school are boys)
- *Knapp Shield* - Top Girls High School (all competitors for the school are girls)
- *J Johnstone Cup* - Top Mixed High School (competitors for the school include boys and girls)

The Hawke's Bay Secondary Schools Surf Life Saving Pool Championship Title will be awarded to the school, from all categories, accumulating the most points.

## Individual Titles

Individuals will gather points as per the point structure above. Where a non-surf lifesaving member places ahead of a surf lifesaving member, the highest placing surf lifesaving member will win the surf lifesaving title, and so on down to 3<sup>rd</sup> place.

The individual with the most points will win the following titles:

- M/F U12 SLS and/or HBSS Pool Champion
- M/F U14 SLS and/or HBSS Pool Champion
- M/F U16 SLS and/or HBSS Pool Champion
- M/F U19 SLS and/or HBSS Pool Champion
- M/F Open SLS Pool Champion
- M/F Masters SLS Pool Champion
