NOTE THE ABOVE AWARDS ARE SEPARATE AWARDS. THE INSTRUCTORS TRAINING COURSE IS A MANDATORY COMPONENT FOR ALL OF THESE AWARDS, HOWEVER THEY EACH THEN HAVE DIFFERENT COMPONENTS REQUIRED.
