The Surf Lifeguard Award is the first step on the Surf Life Saving New Zealand lifeguard pathway.

Wednesday at Taiora: QEII is the 400m swim and theory exam.

Wednesday at South Brighton SLSC: practical & beach components.

Requirements: Participate in full courses as required for qualification
Complete all practical requirements as necessary
Complete all theory requirements – full workbook completion prior to weekend is mandatory for some qualification.
