COVID-19 Pool Champs Update #2

The government's recent COVID-19 update on 6/09/2021 introducing Delta Level 2 restrictions, has seen mass gathering numbers for indoor events reduced from 100 to 50.

As a result of the government's new Delta Level 2 restrictions, **the Eastern Region Pool Champs will be postponed.**

A further decision/update on the Eastern Region Pool Champs will be made on 14/15 September 2021 post the government's announcement on the 13 September 2021.

In the meantime, we are working with our Council and facility partners to explore options and venues for us to deliver the Eastern Region Pool Champs under Delta Level 2 restrictions and council venue guidelines.

What is important is that we continue to provide quality experiences at surf events while being able to ensure the safety and wellbeing of all involved, without effecting the integrity and quality of our events.

Should Eastern Region Pool Champs unfortunately be cancelled and the NZ Pool Rescue Championships are able to be proceed, individual times of our Eastern Region competitors will be used from NZ Pool Rescue Championships to determine Eastern Regions champions.
