## What is happening?

SLSNZ is providing a series of 2-3 hr Operational Risk Assessment (ORA) workshops throughout the Northern, Eastern, Central and Southern regions during Oct-Nov and early Dec as COVID restrictions allow. These workshops are designed to cover the fundamentals of risk management and the use of the new ORA APP to help inform and encourage safe practices across all surf lifesaving operations including patrols, lifeguard and surf sport training, SAR OPS as well as internal and external events and nippers training.

## Why is it happening?

Clubs and members have requested support to better understand risk management and how it can be utilised to assist our operational practices. These ORA workshops are designed to inform and support those responsible for the health and safety of members and may include PCs, Deputy PCs, Coaches, H&S Officers, SAR teams etc., all of whom will have free access to SLSNZ's ORA APP.
