This is a junior carnival covering individual disciplines: Run swim run, surf race, diamond race, board race.

Fluro vests must be worn for all water events.

Wetsuits can be work.

Athlete Management:

Athletes will not be allowed onto the beach until the arena manager has communicated that it is allowed. Athletes will be allowed into the marshalling tent on the beach once the previous age group has left the beach. Please keep all athletes and spectators behind the spectators roped off area until given permission. Under the traffic light Covid regulations must be adhered to as the Hawkes Bay is in Orange and there are athletes under 12 years old there will be maximum group sizes of 50.

Marshalling tent. Once permission is given the athletes of that age group make their way to the marshalling tent. They are to take with them all their gear required, boards, goggles, towels, drink bottle etc. **Parents are NOT allowed onto the beach into the marshalling tent.** The athletes will then

be marshalled and will race back to back until their races have finished. Once all the races are finished they will then be walked back out of the marshalling area.

Each age group will have 60 minutes per session to complete a shortened programme, this includes warmup/marshalling. At the conclusion of the programme, all club members must leave the beach promptly to allow the next age group to arrive. Clubs can chose to use the same managers and coaches throughout all age groups on the day or have different managers and coaches for each age group.

Active Members:

To be entered the competitors must be Active/Rolled Over into the current season. Please speak to your club administrator to get this sorted.

New members need to have applied on the [Join a Club](#) page on the website. The club admin then needs to accept their membership application – info in the [CRM User Manual](#) (page 19-20) for doing this via the CRM or the [Applications](#) user guide if using the Portal.

Participation :

Due to Covid traffic light systems there will be **no participation arena at the carnival**. Clubs are encouraged to attend their usual beaches for participation junior surf Sundays.

200m Badges:

All U11 – U14 water events competitors must have a current 200m Safety Badge to enter any water events (more information on this award can be found on page 37 of the [Junior Surf Manual](#)). Clubs must add this award for each junior competitor intending to compete in the events mentioned above. This needs to be created in the database **every season** – an award created in the previous season **will not** carry through into the current season, therefore a new 200m Safety Badge or 200m Safety Badge Refresher must to be added. This can be done in the [CRM](#) (page 23-24) or in the [Portal](#).

Competition Divisions:

Events will be set up to allow competitors to only be entered into their age division. There will be no racing up divisions. The divisions that will be available at this seasons events are U11, U12, U13 and U14.

A Competitor's division will be determined by their gender and their age on 30 September midnight annually for the current competition season.

Officials:

This year we will again have the **SLSNZ Surf Official Policy** in place. All clubs will need to provide one qualified surf official for every 10 athletes competing. More information can be found in policies [SPS001](#) and [SPS002](#).

Covid:

All spectators and athletes please scan in at the QR code stations (these will be on display in the arena and spectator area), wearing a mask is recommended. Once an athlete has finished the races they are registered for they are encouraged to leave the beach.

Due to the new traffic light system there will be strict measures in place to ensure that only athletes and coach are allowed on the beach, absolutely NO spectators.

Athletes will be marshalled by the Officials in age groups. Each age group will have a separate time allocated for competing. As detailed in the programme. Once an age groups races have finished the athletes are to leave the beach allowing for the next age group of athletes to be marshalled.

Social distancing must be adhered to by spectators at all times and masks are highly recommended.

If the programme goes over time the next age group waiting will not be called by the Officials until they have cleared the arena from the previous group.

Wetsuits:

Wetsuits are optional (and recommended) for all Junior Surf competitors up until Christmas. After Christmas the decision to allow wetsuits for U11-U14 competitors will be made by the Event management committee pending water temperature and weather conditions on the day of the event. The decision will be communicated to the team managers and will then be their responsibility to communicate the decision to their members.

It is recommended that all parents prepare for events by **always** packing a wetsuit for their child/children, regardless of the weather forecast. This way if a ruling is made to allow wetsuits your child will not be hindered in anyway. Again, it is up to the club Junior Surf Coordinators/Team Mangers to circulate this message to your members.

Fluro Safety Vests:

It is **compulsory** for all Surf Sport competitors to compete wearing a SLSNZ sanctioned fluro safety vest. Any competitor found not wearing a fluro safety vest will not be allowed to enter the water. This applies to all age groups and events. No exceptions. More information can be found [here](#).

Communication and Code of Conduct:

During an event all communication must go through the Team Manager. No parent, coach or competitor should approach the Arena or Event Referee directly.

No matter what role you hold on the day of an event any abuse or interference from any person will not be tolerated, and any competitor/parent/helper/coach or official judged to show behaviour that is obstructive, offensive or dangerous will be asked to leave the beach.

Parking and Beach access:

Parking is to be off Ferguson ave, **Westshore SLS Club is out of bounds** for those attending the carnival. Public toilets can be used access via the bike path behind the club. Spectators to stay on the bank behind the roped off area.
