Event Entries:

For the events this season, we will again be using the online event entry system [Enter NOW](#).

Entries will close at 8am on the Wednesday prior to events, any late entries will incur a fee of \$15 on top of the normal entry fee

Programme:

Note: This programme is subject to change due to entry numbers.

U8 - U10 athletes will use a body board for their races, unless competing in the 200m badge events.

Only the following competitors will be permitted to be at the beach during the following time slots:

0830 – 1030 – U10's, U9's & U8 – (Managers Meeting – 0800)

1100 – 1300 – U11's & U12's – (Managers Meeting – 1045)

1330 – 1530 – U14's & U13's – (Managers Meeting – 1300)

Each age group will have 120 minutes per session to complete a shortened programme, this includes warmup/marshalling. At the conclusion of the programme, all club members must leave the beach promptly to allow the next age group to arrive.

Clubs can chose to use the same managers and coaches throughout all age groups on the day or have different managers and coaches for each age group.

The total number of team/age group managers and coaches for a club will be dependent on the total number of entries from that club.

Parents and other volunteers will not able to enter the competition area. All members who are not team/age group managers or coaches will be required to stay in the designated tent area.

Age Group Managers / Coach – Shepherd System

Each club will be allocated a number of age group managers and coaches. They will be named Shepherd's for this particular carnival.

Competitors (for example, the u9 girls) will leave their tent area with a designated "Shepherd" and will stay with that adult the whole time within the 90 minute time slot. Competitors may return to their tents if need be, but it is strongly advised to keep the "flock" intact for the entire 90 minutes.

Shepherds will marshal their flock and collect them from the finish line at the end of each race. It is important that these groups are kept moving between races, so we will endeavour to marshal each flock as a group instead of randomly through Waves.

Clubs will need to provide a detailed list of which competitors are with which volunteer, to help with process. These lists will be due on Friday 26th November at 0900.

Clubs can chose to use the same age group managers and coaches throughout the day. This includes across multiple age groups.

COVID Protection Framework – Vaccination Verification:

In order to deliver this event in the RED CPF it will require all attendees (participants, athletes, coaches, managers, water safety, officials and spectators) aged 12 years and 3 months or older within the defined competition areas to provide proof of vaccination.

Team Managers will fill out a COVID vaccination spreadsheet. We are relying on club administrators to verify that all attending members (competitors, officials, team managers, coaches) from their club are fully vaccinated.

This can be by sighting a MVP or checking on the SLSNZ CRM database.

Once full vaccination is verified all members within the competition space will be required to wear a wristband. Team managers will be able to collect these after the team managers meetings. Wristbands will be used to gain access to the competition arenas.

Competition Divisions:

A Competitor's division will be determined by their gender and their age on 30th September annually for the current competition season.

- Each competitor will need to be entered into the races they want to do. (i.e. Joe Blogs – U14 Male Board, U14 Male Surf Race)
- There will be no entering into races on the day.
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Competition Points & Placings:

Points will be awarded to competitors placed from 1st until 6th place. (1st = 6 points, 2nd = 5 point etc)

Team's events will be awarded double points from 1st until 6th place. (1st = 12points, 2nd = 10 points)

Officials:

This year we will again have the **SLSNZ Surf Official Policy** in place. All clubs will need to provide one qualified surf official for every 10 athletes competing. More information can be found in policies [SPS001](#) and [SPS002](#).

Parking and Beach access:

Parking will be in the public carpark along the foreshore. Parking space will be limited so please make sure you are there early with your trailers to get a park.

Prize giving & Medals:

Due to the current layout of this event & COVID – 19 restrictions, we will not be hosting a prize giving for this event. Medals will be handed to clubs for distribution.

The Capital Coast Junior Surf Trophy will also be awarded in a similar manner to last season.
