Modified Event Entry Requirements

Modified Entry Information

Entries may be made using the SLSNZ Online Event Entry System. Your club has access to this system and will process your entries. Following the close of entry as detailed below, entry fees will be invoiced directly to your club for payment prior to the competition.

Entries Open:	10:00am, 10 th January 2022
All Entries Close:	5:00pm, 10th February 2022 – No late entries will be taken
Entry Fee:	\$115.00 per person (incl. GST)
Masters Entry Fee	\$75.00 per person (incl. of GST)

Important information:

While we are planning for the best, there is still significant uncertainty and risk associated with delivering 2022 TSB Nationals. Detailed information can be found [here](#).

Under the COVID Protection Framework RED setting, Events and Gatherings are restricted to 100 people (this excludes officials and other event volunteers) in a single 'defined space'. However, there can be multiple, separated 'defined spaces' at a location.

With respect to TSB Nationals this means we can operate multiple arenas on the beach as long as they are separated and only have 100 people in them. However, **there can be no intermingling between arenas and each arena must stay as it is for the entire duration of the event, with no new groups formed.**

This means competitors will be restricted to one age/gender arena for all individual & team events for the entire competition. The outcome of this is:

- Individuals can only be entered into and compete in their eligible age group.
- Each Age/gender group will be limited to 100 entries.
- Teams can only be made up of one age group - no competing up to fill spaces in other age groups. **There will now be U15 team events.**
- Equipment e.g. Boards & Skis cannot be shared between different Arenas
- Arenas will be separated into single age & gender groups (8 groups for beach & small craft)
- It is highly unlikely that we will have the resources to operate 8 small craft & 2 boat/canoe arenas simultaneously, therefore our current approach is to run morning (female) & afternoon (male) sessions in 4 water Arenas with staggered access times in beach arenas and 2 boat/canoe Arenas also with morning (female) & afternoon (male) sessions.
- This will effectively halve the time available to deliver the traditional programme and therefore potentially halve the number of events able to be delivered. It will also significantly decrease the rest time between heats/semis/finals and between different disciplines.

Once initial entries have been received, the Event Management Committee will be able provide a draft programme to clubs.

Event Modifications:

Masters:

- Male and Female Groups will be limited to 100 entries.
- Dependent on entry numbers and logistics (Officials/Water Safety/Equipment) we envisage using 5 Arenas as defined spaces on Thursday:
 - 1) Male Arena
 - 2) Female Arena
 - 3) Boat and Canoe Arena
 - 4) Sprint Arena
 - 5) Flag pit area
- **Masters Boat and Canoe crews must stay in their Arena and may not compete in any Individual or teams events in the Male or Female arena.**
- There will be no spectators, Coaches, or Team Managers allowed into these Arenas, they will have dedicated gathering points. **They will have to scan in, and show MVP, and then will be unable to leave and join any other gathering point set up by SLSNZ on the beach.**
- **Competitors must clear the beach immediately following the completion of racing.**
- **There will be no Prizegiving, or Masters dinner held.** medals will be available in the arena to be picked up

Senior beach and small craft

- Individuals can only be entered into and compete in their age group.
- Each Age/gender group will be limited to 100 entries.
- Teams can only be made up of one age group - no competing up to fill spaces in other age groups. There will now be U15 teams events.
- Equipment e.g. Boards & Skis cannot be shared between different Arenas
- No Mixed Double Ski.
- Open Mens Taplin reduced from 6 person teams to 3 person teams (Data shows over half the competitors in the Open Male 6 man taplin are from younger age groups).
- Dependent on entry numbers and logistics (Officials/Water Safety/Equipment) we envisage using 6 Arenas as defined spaces over 3 days:
 - 1) U15 Arena
 - 2) U17 Arena
 - 3) U19 Arena
 - 4) Open Arena
 - 5) Sprint Track
 - 6) Flags Pit Arena.
- Competitors must clear the beach area immediately following the completion of racing.
- There will be no Prizegiving. Medals will be available in the arena to be picked up.
- There will be no spectators, Coaches, or Team Managers allowed into these Arenas, they will have dedicated gathering spaces. **They will have to scan in, and show MVP, and then will be unable to leave and join any other gathering point set up by SLSNZ on the beach.**

Senior Competitor Boats and Canoes

- Dependent on entry numbers and logistics (Officials/Water Safety/Equipment) we envisage using 2 Arenas as defined spaces over 3 days (Boats utilising any spare time in the Canoe Arena)
 - 1) Boat Arena (3 days, 2 sessions daily: split am/pm)
 - 2) Canoe Arena (2 days, 2 sessions daily: split am/pm)

Boats: (based off 2021 entry numbers)

- 2 days: Morning Session U19 & U23 Females / Afternoon session U19 & U23 Males
- 2 days: Morning Session Open Females / Afternoon session Open Males
- **Sweeps are not allowed to move between different groups – Open sweeps will not be able to Sweep any U19 or U23 Crews in the above scenario.**
- **Boat Competitors are not allowed to move between bubbles – no canoe competitor may compete in the beach/small craft Individual/Teams arenas**
- All divisions will be restricted to 100 individual persons (16 crews of 6 persons).
- No Mixed Boat Relay.
- Competitors must clear the beach area immediately following the completion of racing.
- There will be no Prizegiving medals will be available in the arena to be picked up.
- There will be no spectators, Coaches, or Team Managers allowed into these Arenas, they will have dedicated gathering spaces. **They will have to scan in, and show MVP, and then will be unable to leave and join any other gathering point set up by SLSNZ on the beach.**

Canoes: (based off 2021 entry numbers)

- 2 days: Morning Session U19 & Open Females / Afternoon session U19 & Open Males
- **Canoe Competitors are not allowed to move between bubbles – no canoe competitor may compete in the beach/small craft Individual/Teams arenas**
- Age Groups will be limited to 100 individual persons (20 crews of 5 persons).
- Competitors must clear the beach area immediately following the completion of racing.
- There will be no Prizegiving medals will be available in the arena to be picked up.
- There will be no spectators, Coaches, or Team Managers allowed into these Arenas, they will have dedicated gathering points. **They will have to scan in, and show MVP, and then will be unable to leave and join any other gathering point set up by SLSNZ on the beach.**

The following events and divisions (listed in no particular order) are available to be entered. As highlighted above, it is highly unlikely all events will be able to be delivered in the time available.
