Entry Fee:	\$20.00 (inc gst) clubs will be invoiced directly
High Visibility Vests:	High Visibility Vests are compulsory for all water event competitors. This includes all warm-up and warm-down sessions.
Racing Uniform:	Club Caps are compulsory
200m Award:	Current and refreshed to be eligible for water events
Competition Safety Plan:	The Competition Safety Plan will be available on the SLSNZ website prior to the event commencing; a copy will be held on site for the duration of the event.

Age groups:

Competitor age groups are defined as the competitor's age at midnight on 30th September 2022. For example if you are 11 on the 30th September 2022, you will race in the U12 age group.

For all Individual Events the age groups which athletes will compete in are: U11, U12, U13, U14. Athletes are only allowed to compete in one age group the entire event.

For all Team Events the age groups which athletes will compete in are: U12 = U12 & U11 year olds, U14 = U14 & U13 year olds. E.g. A club has a board relay team in the 12 board relay, this may have a mixture of U11 & U12 athletes in the team of 3.
