### **EVENT INFORMATION:**

This is a fun junior carnival covering individual and team events.

Sprints and Flags Age groups: U7, U8, U9, U10, U11, U12, U13, U14

Relay Age Groups: 7-8, 9-10, 11-12, 13 -14

Tug a War Challenge: 1 person from each age group (teams can be made up on the day and composite teams can be made.

### **EVENT PROGRAMME:**

Age groups will be split up into different arenas starting with:

Sprints: U10 – U14 age groups

Flags: U7 - U9 age groups

## **EVENT PROGRAMME CONTINUED:**

Relays: Egg and Spoon: 7-8 to 9-10 age groups

Three Legged Race: 11-12 to 13-14 age groups

Sprint Relays: 13-14, 11-12, 9-10, 7-8

Tug o War Club Challenge – one per each Age Group 7-14 years

This year we will again have the SLSNZ Surf Official Policy in place. All clubs will need to provide one qualified surf official for every 10 athletes competing.

## **PARKING AND BEACH ACCESS:**

Parking will be in the public carpark along the Hardinge Road foreshore please be mindful of members of the public.

## **Competiton Caps:**

It is **compulsory** for all competitors to wear their Club or Junior Surf Club caps.

## **Communication and Code of Conduct:**

During an event all communication must go through the Team Manager. No parent, coach or competitor should approach the Arena or Event Referee directly.

*No matter what role you hold on the day of an event any abuse or interference from any person will not be tolerated, and any competitor/parent/helper/coach or official judged to show behaviour that is obstructive, offensive or dangerous will be asked to leave the beach.*
