Subject: COVID Catch Up

Hi Team,

We are seeing an increase in Covid 19 within the community but also within the Surf Community.

We need to be mindful please of some basic messaging with our members

- If you are sick please stay away from the surf club, trainings, patrols, office or meetings
- If you have Covid symptoms please take a RAT Test and stay at home
- If you have a family member/person you live test positive to covid please take a RAT Test daily for 5 days from the day of their first positive test
- If at the Surf Club for patrol or Beach Ed where ever possible please aim to open doors and windows (where and when possible) to allow good ventilation and air flow
- We strongly encourage you to wear masks if in confirmed spaces with other members or members of the public i.e. in the 1st Aid Room
- Remember to use good hand and personal hygiene
