## Event Entry Process:

Entries are made by using the SLSNZ Online Event Entry System. To access the Waves system please follow this [link](#) and use your club allocated password details as sent to the club administrators.

## Entries close Monday 7<sup>th</sup> August 2023 – 1000

### **Please note:**

- **We ask clubs to only enter athletes in events that they intend on competing in.**
- **Team Manager's contact details:** Must be entered in Waves to ensure that the relevant person receives all updated information directly. Failure to list a team manager may mean that you will miss out on vital information.
- **Entering Teams:** You must enter the required number of people as specified for team events otherwise your entry in that event will not be accepted.

All entry fees will be calculated via the online entry system following the close of entries and your club will be invoiced directly. The entry system allows clubs to download a quote for the event to use as reference which can be found at the bottom of the event entry page. Any athlete that shows up and races but is not entered will be invoiced as a late entry.

## Eligibility of Competitors

This competition is open to any SLSNZ affiliated club. Without the following details your members will not be eligible to compete nor will they be able to be entered through the online entry system. SLSNZ reserve the right to limit the number of competitors per event.

## Age Groups:

The NZ Pool Events programme is scheduled before the beach based events for the current season and therefore a competitor's age group is determined by their age as at midnight on 30 September 2023. This is to allow athletes to remain in the same age group for the entire season. For example, if you are 14 on 30 of September 2023, you are not eligible to race in the U14 age group and will be in the U15 age group.

### Please Note:

1. All competitors must be aged 10 years or older before midnight 30 September 2023 to be eligible to compete in this event.
  2. Competitors (individual and team events) may compete in age groups as detailed below:
    - U11/U12 may compete only in U12 events
    - U13/U14 may compete only in U14 events
  3. **Competitors can only compete in any event once** (individual and team events), for example an U12 competitor wishing to compete in the 50m with Fins may only compete in the U12 age group event.

## Time Keepers and Water Crew:

A large number of time keepers and water crew are required to ensure the successful running of the event. As such, each competing club will be required to supply 2 timekeepers and 1 water crew for the event.

## Clarification of Swim Fins Specifications for U11-U14 Pool Rescue Events

To clarify the interpretation of rule 12.18(f) for Fins allowed per age group.

All ages can wear either Pool or Ocean Fins: Closed Foot Piece Rubber Fins, or Pool or Ocean Fins: Heel Band. To clarify, this includes standard fins used in pool training, and in surf lifesaving ocean events where fins can be worn (i.e. Run Swim Run with Fins, and Tube Rescue)

The swim fins used in events for U14 – U11 events are restricted to soft/flexible rubber type fins used for swimming training similar to the styles depicted below

Fin Options – a style of fin traditionally used in life saving or short blade fin used for swim training

## **Event Descriptions:**

The following is a brief description of each event for entry purposes.

Please consult the New Zealand Pool Championships Competition Manual for a full break down of all event general conditions and specific event rules and regulations.

### **Swim with Obstacles (50m, 100m, 200m)**

The competitor swims the prescribed distance in freestyle during which he/she swims under one (1) immersed obstacle per 25m.

### **100m Tube Patient Tow with Fins (U12)**

The rescuer swims 75m freestyle to the other end and clips their patient into a tube. The patient must have at least one hand on the end of the pool. The Rescuer and patient then swim the other 25m where the patient must stay on their back but may assist the tow by kicking and sculling under the water.

### **100m Tube Patient Tow with Fins (U14)**

The patient will swim 50m freestyle and upon touching the turn wall and raising their hand, the 'rescuer' will swim 25m freestyle with fins and rescue tube to pick up the patient, clip them into the tube and return to the start.

### **100m Manikin Tow with Fins**

The competitor swims 75m freestyle with fins and rescue tube. After touching the turning edge, the competitor secures the rescue tube around a manikin floating at the surface and tows it to the finish

### **100m Rescue Medley**

The competitor swims 75m freestyle to turn, dive and swim underwater to a submerged manikin located at 12.5m from the wall. The competitor surfaces the manikin within the 5m pick up line and then carries it the remaining distance to touch the finish wall.

### **50m Swim with Fins**

The competitor swims 50m freestyle with fins.

### **50m Manikin Carry without Fins**

The competitor swims 25m freestyle and then dives to recover a submerged manikin to the surface within 5m of the pick-up line. The competitor then carries the manikin to the finish edge of the pool.

### **50m Brick Carry without Fins**

The competitor swims 30/35m freestyle and then dives to recover a submerged rubber brick to the surface within 5m of the pick-up line. The competitor then carries the rubber brick to the finish edge of the pool.

### **Line Throw**

In this timed event, the competitor throws an un weighted line to a fellow team member located in the water approximately 12.5m distant and pulls this "victim" back to the poolside.

### **4x50m Obstacle Relay**

Four competitors swim 50m freestyle each passing under one (2) immersed obstacles.

### **4x50m Medley Relay**

The first competitor swims 50m freestyle without fins. The second competitor swims 50m freestyle with fins. The third competitor swims 75m freestyle pulling a rescue tube and after having touched the wall, passes the harness of the rescue tube to a fourth competitor who wears fins. The third competitor becomes the "victim," holds the rescue tube with both hands, while being towed 25m by the fourth competitor to the finish.

### **6x25 Super Mega Relay (Junior) 6x50m Mega Relay (Senior)**

The first competitor swims 25m freestyle without fins. The second competitor swims 25m freestyle with fins. The third competitor swims 25m freestyle without fins. The fourth competitor swims 25m freestyle with fins. The fifth competitor swims 25m freestyle without fins. The sixth competitor swims 25m freestyle with fins.

Seniors consists of 1 x Open Male, 1 x Open Female, 1 x U19 Male, 1 x U19 Female, 1 x U17 Male, 1 x U17 Female.

Juniors consists of 3 x Male and 3 x Female
