Flag Stand update

Signbiz are working on these as we speak, aiming for delivery week of the 21st Whakatane we have yet to collect, will arrange a temp swap for the beginning of the season.

Uniforms - can still wear old ones on patrol but if clubs are doing photos, please wear the new AON shirts - if clubs don't have any AON shirts for photos please get in touch with the media team.

Patrol Audits - aim to get 3 audits per club for the big clubs and 2 for the small ones. Will look for a couple more auditors and if necessary will look to use staff. Generally the first 2 weekends in each month for audits. Need a couple in Eastern and Western Bay.

h. Radio Network - Dove Comm should have been out and updated all your club radios. The network has had upgrades which should improve coverage. Bit of an issue with Maketu but Surf Comm can hear them fine. All moving assets (IRB, RWC, ATV) are to use radios on Channel 1.

6. Club Development Update

a. Surf Lifeguard Exam update

The exam went really well at the weekend, some great feedback. Theory was taking a lot longer this year, some close to two hours. **FR** could we look to get theory completed sooner? Time constraints. Please make sure reader writer forms are completed, this helps alot with planning.

We will likely need two exams again in November, and need to assess where candidates are coming from to determine the venue. Opotiki has 4 lifeguards and 3 patrol support, Whakatane 20, Pukehina have approx 10, Pap 13, Omanu 20, MMLS 8.

Currently have Whakatane booked as the venue which can only cater to a max of 20 candidates so we need another venue on the same day.

Reader/writers will need to make an appointment for a private one of one session with an examiner at the Rescue Centre, prior to the main theory exam date.

Clubs need to ensure they keep track of their registered candidates and if they are not attending an exam their registration needs to be withdrawn so we can allow for exact numbers. Clubs to register candidates in correct Course Instance on PAM (SLA or PS).

The beach has the same rules as on the road. Preference would be that someone with a full license is required to drive if you are taking passengers, restricted can drive with an adult supervising and on completion of a full vehicle induction. Learner drivers are not recommended. Check insurance policies for different class drivers.
